Our class is visiting Swale, a new rooftop farm, at Brooklyn Bridge Park on **Tuesday, June 6th at 9:30 am-11am**. We will learn about urban agriculture, including growing local food, composting , and the importance of green roofs. Students can expect to have the hands on experience of assisting in seasonal tasks so they need to be sure to dress appropriately for being outside and possibly getting dirty. The farm recommends that all children and chaperones bring a water bottle and closed-toed shoes. In addition, make sure to wear weather-appropriate layers and sunscreen. It can be both hot and windy on the farm rooftop.
